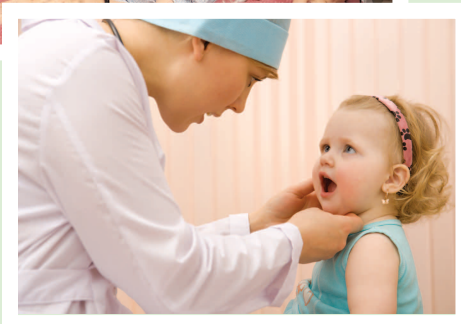




Communication is Key to Quality Care

Care Team - An Intensive Care R.N. and a Respiratory Therapist - can be called any time there is a concern about a patient's condition.

As your healthcare partners, the Care Team will respond immediately to your call and assist the patient's nurse to address your concerns.

Concerned?

If you're concerned because:

- the patient seems to be getting "much sicker" quicker.
- something doesn't look right.
- something doesn't feel right.
- you notice a change in/or difficulty breathing.
- the patient's heart rate changes.
- there is much more - or much less - urine.
- the patient is suddenly confused or agitated, and doesn't recognize family and friends, or, doesn't know where they are.
- there is a drop in blood pressure.
