The Bellevue Community Days Celebration was a success, and The Bellevue Hospital was honored to have a strong presence during this year's celebration held June 23 - 25.

The Bellevue Hospital Foundation's Fourth Annual D. Ross Irons Memorial 5K Run/Walk was held on Friday, June 24 at the Bellevue High School with nearly 120 runners/walkers. Proceeds from the event will benefit the hospital's Women's Mammography Fund to offer screening mammograms for underinsured or uninsured individuals.

The Bellevue Hospital Foundation also hosted the ninth annual Dr. Elbert Lawrence Classic Car, Motorcycle & Truck Show on Saturday, June, 25 with nearly 50 vehicles participating. All proceeds will benefit healthcare programming for women and children.

The Community Days Parade, held on Saturday, June 25, saw Michael K. Winthrop, President and CEO of TBH, serve as the parade's Grand Marshal. Thirty TBH employees, family members, and volunteers walked in the parade.

"The Bellevue Hospital is beginning to prepare for its 100th Anniversary, which will be March 6, 2017. In preparation, we are rolling out our centennial logo, which made its debut during the Community Days Parade.
